There is no formal register for branches and subsidiaries of German banks abroad. Nonetheless, information is available that is comparable to the selected master data for MFIs (MaMFI).

All majority-owned foreign branches and subsidiaries, that are institutions whose registered office or seat of management is located abroad, and which are regarded as banks in the country concerned, of German banks. If a bank owns several branches in one country of domicile there is just one report. Branches and subsidiaries are separated so that there are two non-overlapping number ranges of the original identifier. However, there is information about change of the type of institute.
