

Data protection notice

Contact details such as personal email addresses or the names of contact persons and their telephone numbers constitute personal data and must therefore be treated in accordance with data protection requirements. Data will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1) point (e) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in conjunction with Section 3 of the German Federal Data Protection Act (*Bundesdatenschutzgesetz*).

The above-mentioned personal data, which are used to contact participants for the first time, are taken from the Deutsche Bundesbank's database of enterprises; further surveys will use the data that enterprises provide to the Deutsche Bundesbank.

Your personal data will be stored for a maximum of five years after the last survey has been completed.
