- the evaluation of macroprudential tools and unconventional monetary policy on financial institutions
- the effects of financial market regulation on the real economy
- the impact of regulation on competition among banks and other financial institutions
- the market entrance and exit of financial institutions
- the coordination of supervision and regulation
- the impact of capital regulation on bank behavior
- the interaction of liquidity and solvency risk
- the interaction of banking and trading (e.g. bank business models, compensation)

The keynote speaker will be Amit Seru (Stanford University).
