

Auction announcement Reopening of five-year Federal notes (Bundesobligationen – “Bobl”) series 160 by auction

As already announced in the issue calendar for the second quarter of 2011, the Federal Government will reopen the

2.75 % five-year Federal notes series 160 of 2011 (2016)
ISIN DE0001141604 // WKN 114 160

on 18 May 2011, using an auction procedure. An increase of €6 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of this series amounts to €6 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.

from 8.00 a. m. until 11.00 a. m. Frankfurt time

Characteristics of the five-year Federal notes:

Maturity: 8 April 2016

Interest payment: annually on 8 April, interest has begun to accrue on 8 April 2011

First interest payment: 8 April 2012 for 366 days
