Announcement of auction Reopening of 30-year Federal bonds

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the fourth quarter of 2014, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

2.50 % bonds of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2014 (2046)

issued on 26 February 2014 - ISIN DE0001102341 // SIN 110 234

on 22 October 2014, using an auction procedure. An increase of €2 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to €5 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.
