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Announcement Federal Treasury discount paper (Bubills)

According to the issuance schedule of the German Federal Government for the first quarter of 2021 the following Bubills will be reopened by a multi-ISIN auction on 15 February 2021:

Reopening Federal Treasury discount paper (Bubills) July 2020 issue / maturity 12 months ISIN DE0001030237 Current volume: €13.5 billion Due on 28 July 2021 Residual maturity: 5 months (161 interest days)

Reopening Federal Treasury discount paper (Bubills) January 2021 issue / maturity 12 months ISIN DE0001030336 Current volume : €4 billion Due on 19 January 2022 Residual maturity: 11 months (336 interest days)

A total amount of $\in 6$ billion is envisaged for the reopened Bubills (including respective retention quote) with a planned share of $\in 3$ billion for each Bubill. The effective increase amount of each Bubill will be determined as part of the auction allotment on 15 February 2021.

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Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid. Bids are to be submitted through the Bund Bidding System BBS and must be for a par value of not less than €1 million or an integral multiple thereof. The price bids must be expressed in terms of full 0.00005 percentage points. Non-competitive bids are possible. The bids accepted by the issuer will be allotted at the price specified in the bid. Non-competitive bids are filled at the weighted average price of the bids accepted. The right to scale down bids is reserved.
