The conference calls for papers from finance, economics and law especially covering topics on the link between financial intermediation and regulation, including (but not limited to)

- the effects of financial market regulation on the real economy
- the impact of regulation on competition among banks and other financial institutions
- the market entrance and exit of financial institutions
- the coordination of supervision and regulation
- the political economy of financial regulation
- the relevance of digitization for financial markets and their regulation

The dinner speech will be given by Felix Hufeld (President of the German Federal Financial Supervisory Authority – BaFin). The keynote speakers will be Antoinette Schoar (MIT and CEPR) and Viral Acharya (Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India, New York University and CEPR).
