Announcement of auction Reopening 10-year Federal bond

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the second quarter of 2020, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

0 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2020 (2030)

issued on 8 January 2020 - ISIN DE0001102499

on 20 May 2020, using an auction procedure. An increase of ≤ 4 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to ≤ 21 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.
