# Announcement of auction Reopening 30-year Federal bond

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the first quarter of 2022, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

**0 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2021 (2052)**  
issued on 1 September 2021 - ISIN DE0001102572

on 12 January 2022, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 1.5 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to € 7.5 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.
