Invitation to bid

Reopening of the 1.30% five-year Green Federal notes (“Bobl”) of 2022 (2027)

Increase of the conventional 1.30% five-year Federal notes series 186 of 2022 (2027)

For the account of the Federal Government, the German Finance Agency, through Deutsche Bundesbank, will reopen the

1.30 % five-year Green Federal notes of 2022 (2027)
due on 15 October 2027

launched on 31 August 2022, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 1.5 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to € 5 billion.

Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid. Bids must be for a par value of not less than € 1 million or an integral multiple thereof. The price bids must be expressed in terms of full 0.01 percentage points. Non-competitive bids are possible. The bids accepted by the issuer will be allotted at the price specified in the bid. Non-competitive bids are filled at the weighted average price of the competitive bids accepted. The right to scale down bids is reserved.

Increase of the conventional 1.30% five-year Federal notes series 186 of 2022 (2027)

On 21 March 2023, the outstanding volume of the conventional twin bond, the 1.30% five-year Federal note series 186 of 2022 (2027), due on 15 October 2027, ISIN DE0001141869, will be increased by € 1.5 billion with effect from 23 March 2023. This increase will be added to the Federal Government's own holdings. The new outstanding volume of the conventional 1.30% five-year Federal note series 186 of 2022 (2027) will be € 28.5 billion.
