## Announcement of auction Reopening 7-year Federal bond

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the third quarter of 2024, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

## 2.40 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2023 (2030) issued on 26 July 2023 - ISIN DE000BU27006

on 31 July 2024, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 3 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and retention quote). The current volume of the bond amounts to € 22 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.
